

2022 Dues Collection FAQs

Q. When does the dues collection process begin?

A. October 16th. Our state bylaws give the chapters until Oct 15th to announce increases at the chapter level.

Q. When does the dues collection process end?

A. We're asking that dues be submitted not later than November 30th. That gives us the month of December to reconcile our membership with national and pay them their portion.

Q. What happens if my payment gets to you after November 30th?

A. It depends on where we are in the reconcile process. Worst case scenario is that national is informed that you are a drop and we will process you as a reinstatement after January 1st.

Q. Did national SAR raise their dues?

A. No. They remain at \$35 unless you are a national life or emeritus member.

Q. Did South Carolina SAR raise their dues?

A. No. They remain at \$20 unless you are a state life or emeritus member.

Q. Will I receive a dues notice?

A. Maybe... Dues notices will be sent out but if your contact information at national is not correct, you may not receive a notice. There is also a spreadsheet posted on the state website that lists all the members that owe dues and how much they owe. The list will be revised regularly to remove names of those who have paid.

Q. What if I wish to become a national life member?

A. National requires that life membership becomes effective the year the application is approved to avoid dues for the following year. If your application is approved after January 1st, you will still owe the \$35 for that year. Fill out your application and send it to the state secretary along with your check. Follow the instructions on the form for payment information. The application is available on the state and national websites.

Q. What if I wish to become a state life member?

A. SC bylaws require state life applications be submitted only by national life members or in conjunction with a national life application. Fill out your application and send it to the state secretary along with your check. Follow the instructions on the form for payment information. The application is available on the state website.

Q. How is state life membership handled?

A. State life membership is effective when it is received assuming the application is submitted with or subsequent to a national life membership.

Q. I am a national and state life member. Where do I send my chapter dues?

A. Since there is no national or state involvement required, it is suggested you pay your chapter directly, however any chapter dues received by the state will be forwarded to the chapter. Please save us that extra step, but please also let us know.

Q. Can I send the state a check for national and state and a separate check to the chapter for chapter dues?

A. Yes. The state’s interest is collecting state and national dues. We remit chapter dues to the chapters at the end of the process. Paying your chapter dues directly to the chapter saves us a step and gets the chapter their money sooner, but if you send us a separate check for your chapter, we will forward it to them.

Q. Where do I send my dues check?
