Rational for Change:

1. Bylaw VIII-2(b) allows the Annual Meeting to take place as early as 1 January. Bylaw VIII-2(d) mandates that notice of that meeting be placed in the Spring edition of The Palmetto Patriot. The Spring edition is not published 30 days prior to a 1 January meeting as required in Bylaw VIII-2(d).
